**YUZU PRESS  
INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION  
IN NEWSPAPER CARTOON**

The Presse Citron / BnF Press Prize for students, which has been organised for the past 33 years by the Ecole Estienne of Paris and great partners, is open to all students from schools of art and design in France.

Several years ago, an international competition has been created: the Yuzu Press Prize. It is open to all students attending art and design schools worldwide, except those in mainland France. The Yuzu Press Prize will be adjudicated by a panel of professional cartoonists and presented on 26<sup>th</sup> March 2026 at the Bibliothèque Nationale de France in Paris.

## **ARTICLE 1 (PARTICIPANTS)**

The Yuzu Press Prize is open to all students from art schools worldwide (including Visual and Fine Arts, Applied Arts, Digital Art and Design), except those in mainland France.

## **ARTICLE 2 (SUBJECT)**

The cartoons presented must illustrate an aspect of current news, occurring between April 2025 and March 2026, inclusive. The image itself should not include any text. However, it may be accompanied by a caption (in english) outside the frame.

## **ARTICLE 3 (SENDING OF WORK)**

Each participant may send more than one drawing. The cartoons must arrive at Ecole Estienne no later than the 15<sup>th</sup> March 2026. They should be sent by email to: [jeparticipe@tropheepressecitron.fr](mailto:jeparticipe@tropheepressecitron.fr)

## **ARTICLE 4 (FORMAT)**

Each cartoon entry must:

- be A5 format, pdf or jpg, 300 dpi, less than 5 Mo.
- include a file name: <<surname\_forename\_cartoon number.pdf>> or <<surname\_forename\_cartoon number.jpg>>
- mention in the body of the e mail, the competitor's surname, forename, class, school (college or university), town, country, email address and mobile telephone number.

## **ARTICLE 5 (JUDGING)**

The winner will be decided by a jury comprising of professional illustrators. The results will be announced on Friday 21<sup>th</sup> March 2026, on the evening of the award ceremony for the Trophee Presse Citron / BnF. This will take place at the Bibliothèque Nationale de France.

## **ARTICLE 6 (AWARD)**

The winner of the Yuzu Press Prize will receive an award (an original piece of artwork), as well as some gifts from our partners.

## **ARTICLE 7 (LEGAL RIGHTS)**

The winner of the competition will undertake not to claim publication rights. By participating in the Yuzu Press Prize, the entrants unreservedly accept all of its rules and regulations.
