



YUZU PRESS: INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION IN NEWSPAPER CARTOON ILLUSTRATION

The 6th "Presse Citron {BnF}" Press Prize for students, which has been organised for the past 26 years by the Ecole Estienne of Paris, is open to all students from schools of art and design in France. This year, an international competition has been created: the Yuzu Press. It is open to all students attending art and design schools worldwide, except those in mainland France. The Yuzu Press Prize will be adjudicated by a panel of professional cartoonists and presented on the 21st March 2019 at the Mairie of the 13th "arrondissement" in Paris. The organisers will invite the winner to a prize giving ceremony to receive a cheque for 800 €, donated by The National Library of France (Bibliothèque Nationale de France). ARTICLE 1 (PARTICIPANTS)

The 1st Yuzu Press competition is open to all students from schools of Art worldwide (including Visual and Fine Arts, Applied Arts, Digital Art and Design), except those in mainland France.

ARTICLE 2 (SUBJECT)

The cartoons presented must illustrate an aspect of current affairs, occurring between March 2018 and February 2019, inclusive. The image itself should not include any text. However, it may be accompanied by a caption (in english) outside the frame.

ARTICLE 3 (SUBMISSION OF WORK)

Each participant may send more than one drawing. The cartoons must arrive at the Ecole Estienne no later than the 18th February 2019. They should be sent by email to :

ARTICLE 4 (FORMAT)

Each cartoon entry must :

- be A5 format, pdf or jpg, 300 dpi, less than 5 Mo
- include a file name:
<<surname_forename_cartoon number.pdf>> or <<surname_forename_cartoon number.jpg>>
- mention in the body of the e mail :
the competitor's surname and forename
the class
the school (college or university)
the town and country
the e mail address
the mobile telephone number.

ARTICLE 5 (JUDGING)

The winner will be decided by a jury comprising of professional illustrators. The results will be announced on Thursday 21st March 2019, on the evening of the award ceremony for the "Trophée Presse Citron {BnF}". This will take place at the town hall of the 13th district of Paris (Mairie du 13^e arrondissement de Paris).

ARTICLE 6 (INVITATION)

The winner of the Yuzu Press prize will be invited by the organisers to attend the awards ceremony. She or he will be given a return air ticket in advance, as well as being provided with complimentary hotel accommodation for two nights and two meal tickets for the restaurant at the Ecole Estienne. Other participants in the Yuzu Press competition whose cartoon is short-listed for the final adjudication will receive an e mail invitation to the awards evening on 21st March 2019 but they will be responsible for the organisation and costs of their own travel and accommodation.

ARTICLE 7 (AWARD)

The winner of the 1st Trophée Yuzu Press will receive an award (an original piece of artwork), as well as a cheque for 800 €, given by {BnF}.

ARTICLE 8 (LEGAL RIGHTS)

The winner of the competition will undertake not to claim publication rights. By participating in the Trophée Yuzu Press, the entrants unreservedly accept all of its rules and regulations.
